一次世界大戰後,部分中國激進派的知識份子嘗試建立小規模的社群組織。本次演講中我將嘗試追索這些試探性的組織的誕生,將它們置於跨國的背景之中,並指出它們共同的性質。儘管這些嘗試皆短命而終,即使案例和參與者都不多,但我認為這波運動具有影響力,並有助於此後中國共產黨領導人的思考方式。

Chinese Communes before Communism, 1919-1921

Shakhar Rahav, Associate Professor of Department of Asian Studies

University of Haifa, Israel

After the Great War (World War I) some Chinese radical intellectuals attempted to construct small-scale communal organizations. In this talk I will trace the emergence of these attempts, place them within a trans-national context, and point out some of their characteristics. Although these attempts were short-lived I will argue that despite the relatively small number of cases and participants the movement was influential and contributed to the thinking of future leaders of the Chinese Communist Party.

夏海(Shakhar Rahav),以色列籍,現任海法大學亞洲研究系副教授。夏教授係美國加州大學柏克萊分校(University of California, Berkeley)歷史學博士,主要研究領域為中國現代史。著有《The Rise of Political Intellectuals in Modern China》(Oxford University Press, 2015)。本年獲得漢學中心獎助,來臺研究主題為「Constructing Utopias: Chinese Communal Experiments in Global Context, 1919-1923」。
